

Admission Exams

Admission exams are for SAIT admissions only; you will not be able to use the results for another institution. All required formulas, data booklets, and reference documents will be provided.

Cost:

- Each Admission exam costs \$50.

Minimum Grade Requirements:

- **Apprentice Technician and Pre-employment** admission exams require a 70% passing grade to coordinate with AIT standards.
- **All other Admission exam** results must meet the minimum admission requirements of each program (i.e., if the Math requirement for a SAIT program is 50% and the examinee achieves a 55% grade, they would meet the admission requirement). Please review your program's admission requirements prior to taking your SAIT admission exam. The exams can be re-written only following a minimum 60 day period (Please ask Testing staff about rewrite details before taking the exam)

Computer Based Exams:

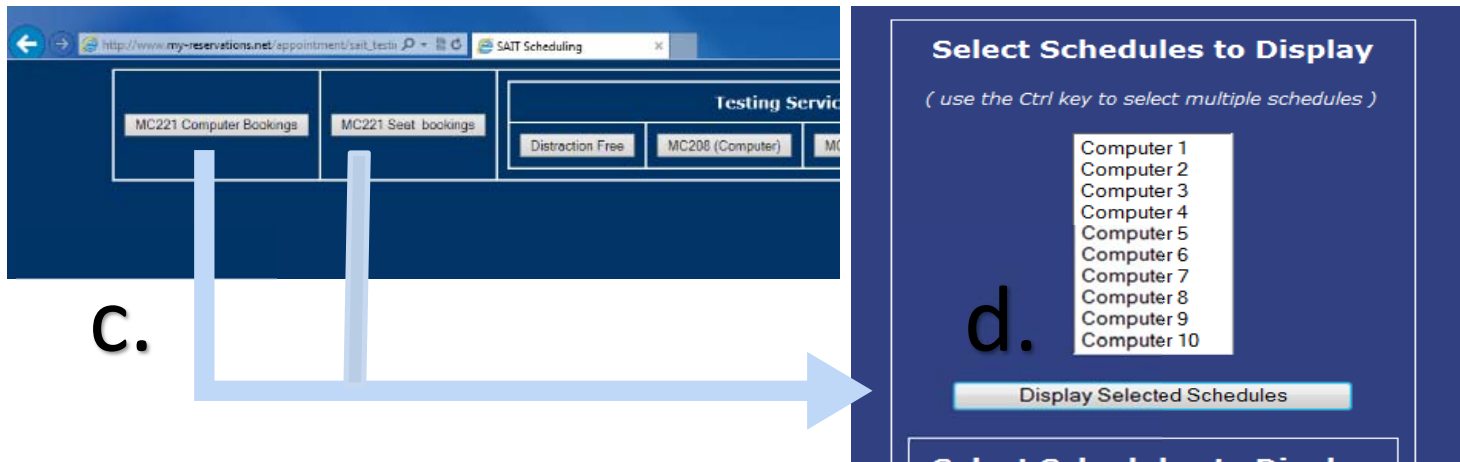
- Pay and register with the Office of the Registrar by phone (403-284-7248) or in person with the course code (s) provided above.
- Book your test time (see below)

Paper-Based Exams:

- Book your test time
- Pay at the time you plan to take your exam(s) with Testing Services

****Book your test time in Advance:**

- a. Testing Services' policy is that students book their exams at least 24 hours in advance.
- b. To book your test time(s), go to www.my-reservations.net/appointment/sait_testing/.
- c. Click on "MC221 Computer Bookings" for computer or "MC221 Seat Bookings" for paper.
- d. Select one or more computers/seats to view availability, click "Display Selected Schedules".



- e. To reserve a computer/seat, click on a free time slot for a computer/ seat that can accommodate the length of your exam. Please refer to the hours of operation when booking your exam.
- f. Fill in the fields and click “Confirm Registration.” Confirmation will be sent to your email.
