

## AC.3.18.1 Recognition of Prior Learning – Credit Courses

## **Transfer Credit/Course Equivalency Evaluation Rubric**

- 1. This rubric is used to determine transfer credit (TC) or course equivalency (CE) at the course level, to provide consistency and transparency in decision-making.
- 2. Overall, the course being evaluated must be an 80% match (strong match) to the course for which credit/equivalency is sought (unless the course is an elective, in which case transfer credit or course equivalency may be granted for a course from an academic discipline or subject area within a discipline that meets the program's elective requirements, and an 80% content match is not required or the Dean responsible for the course has determined that a 70% content match is permissible for an introductory course).
