

AC.3.18.2 Recognition of Prior Learning – Non-Credit Courses

Schedule A: Transfer Credit and Course Equivalency – Evaluation Rubric

- 1. This rubric is used to assess transfer credit (TC) or course equivalency (CE) at the course level, so that there is consistency and transparency in decision-making across SAIT.
- 2. The school/department/program responsible for the course decides whether or not to grant transfer credit/course equivalency. The evaluator may need to request additional information from the student in order to make this assessment.
- 3. Overall, the course being evaluated must be an 80% match (i.e. a strong match) to the SAIT course for which credit/equivalency is sought (unless the course is an elective, in which case transfer credit or course equivalency may be granted for a course from an academic discipline or subject area within a discipline that meets the program's elective requirements, and an 80% content match is not required).

1. Credit/Equivalency Factors Using the information available to you, assess the following factors.		
a.	Course Description	Look for similar wording; high-level similarities.
b.	Topics / Subject(s) covered in course	Review course schedule, map or similar documentation.
C.	Learning Outcomes and Objectives,	Assess cognitive levels in learning outcome and depth of learning required.
d.	Assessments/Evaluations	Review percentage allocation of evaluations, type and nature of assessments.
e.	Course Hours	
f.	Other	Compare textbooks, learning materials, other factors.
