## **EMERGENCY SITUATIONS**

- Violent behaviours or threatening statements.
- Medical emergency.
- Clear, immediate safety concerns to self and/or others.

## **URGENT SITUATIONS**

- · Serious distress.
- Disruptive behaviours.
- Significant changes in mood and academic performance.
- · Possible safety concerns.

## NON-URGENT SITUATIONS

- Personal, behavioural or academic difficulties.
- · No safety concerns.
