Ancillary Fees

- Campus recreation fee - supports SAIT Recreation's programs and facilities to support active and healthy lifestyles for our students.

- Laptop deposit – students in SAIT’s e-Learning program are supplied with a laptop and must pay a refundable security deposit prior to picking up their device.
- Laundry fee – some programs with uniform requirements have an annual laundry fee which provide clean uniforms for pick-up on a set schedule from SAIT’s laundry facilities.
- Student association fee – fees to support SAITSA, the SAIT student association.
- Student support fee – This new fee supports student services and resources to help students succeed throughout their academic careers, for example: Career Advancement Services, Student Development and Counselling, and student awards and bursaries
- Student technology fee – This new fee supports improvements to cybersecurity to protect student and institutional information, access to learning material outside the classroom and technology to enhance the student experience.
- Universal transit pass - The Universal Transit Pass, or UPass, is a sticker applied to a student’s ID card that gives the student unlimited access to Calgary Transit.

Tuition Related Fees

- Application fee – a fee paid at the time of application and covers the cost of reviewing an application and the assessment of documents. Application fees are not refundable.
- Tuition – fees paid to cover the cost of the program course registrations.
- Tuition deposit – a deposit paid to confirm an applicant’s seat in a program. The deposit is applied to tuition once a student is registered. The tuition deposit is normally not refundable.
