


On your way through the THOMAS RILEY BUILDING, take in the beautiful architecture. This building houses many of the programs from our School of Construction.



UNDERSTANDING **ADMISSIONS** REQUIREMENTS.

SAIT admission requirements are based on the Alberta curriculum and its equivalencies. Regardless of where a student attended high school (secondary school), SAIT will evaluate each student's credentials and give course equivalencies under the Alberta curriculum.

MEETING ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All full-time programs have specific admission requirements that you must meet to qualify for admission. All applicants must demonstrate English language proficiency, including students educated in Canada.

If you do not meet the admission requirements, consider enrolling in SAIT's upgrading program(s):

- English Language Foundations program to meet the English language proficiency requirement
- Academic Upgrading program to obtain any core academic subjects (math, physics, chemistry, biology) required for program admission.

GENERAL GUIDELINES INCLUDE

- "30 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 12 or senior level
- "20 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 11 or junior level
- "10 level" courses under the Alberta curriculum are equal to Grade 10

The Alberta curriculum differentiates higher and lower level courses with dashes. Courses listed as "30-1" are considered the highest, while "30-2" courses are considered a lower level.

EARLY ADMISSION

It is important to know when applications open and close prior to submitting your application. Visit sait.ca to confirm dates.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Some programs may require supplementary documentation.

INTERNATIONAL DOCUMENT ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT

If you were educated outside of Canada, you will require an international document assessment to ensure you've met the admission requirements for your program.

SCAN YOUR ORIGINAL HIGH SCHOOL AND/OR POST-SECONDARY DOCUMENTS IN COLOUR, AND ALSO INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:



Secondary and/or post-secondary transcripts, mark sheets and examination results



Secondary diploma or graduation certificate and/or post-secondary degree



Explanation of grading scale (often found on the back or front page of transcripts)



If your documents were not issued in English, you must provide **certified translations and the original documents (in original language)**. Refer to the Association of Translators and Interpreters of Alberta (ATIA) to find a certified translator



Your transcripts must show at least **three years of consecutive education** (secondary and/or post-secondary)



If your name has changed, we will require **validation of name change** (marriage certificate, etc.)



If you have documents from your respective country, you must include additional information.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE FOUNDATIONS

If English isn't your first language and you're looking to build your skills and confidence, our English Language Foundations (ELF) program can help.

Our ELF curriculum helps you develop your English skills in speaking, listening, reading and writing.

With six start dates per year as well as full-time and part-time options, it's easy to build your English skills.

Students are placed in the program based on their CLBA, CLBPT, ELF PPT or academic IELTS score.

HOW TO APPLY ON SAIT'S VIRTUAL ADMISSIONS SYSTEM (VAS).

- Create an account. If you already have an account or if you are an agent sign in here.
- 2. Select "Add Application".
- 3. Enter all the required information, including:



- upload mandatory documents. For best outcomes, we strongly recommend uploading all supporting documents and carefully answering all application questions prior to submitting the form.
- the program(s) you wish to apply for:
 - » Select the desired term first.
 - » After you complete the application for your preferred program, you have the option to choose a second program and combine them into one application.
 - » Choosing two programs must be done during the same application. If you choose only one program and submit your application, you must create and pay for a new application to choose a second program.
 - » You won't be able to modify your program selection after your application has been submitted so review carefully.
- upload mandatory documents.
- review your "Application Summary and Terms and Conditions".
- 4. Pay the non-refundable application fee.
- 5. You will receive an email confirming your application has been received. You can login at sait.vasuniverse.com/auth/signin to edit or view your application or to ask questions regarding your application. We will notify you by email as soon as a decision has been made on your application.

APPLICATION PREFERENCE

When you apply to SAIT, you will be able to select up to two programs per application.

- You will be asked which program is your first choice and which is your second during the application process.
- If your first choice program is not available, the application will be cancelled and you will be evaluated for the second choice program only.
- You will be sent an offer letter if there is space in your chosen program AND you have submitted documents or sufficient evidence to prove you will meet the admission requirements.

Have you already completed some post-secondary studies or gained other relevant experience in the workplace? We'll help you get ahead sooner by transferring to a program that's right for you.



MONEY MATTERS.

A GOOD EDUCATION IS AN INVESTMENT.

Between tuition and books, or the special equipment some programs require, costs can add up. We want to make sure **you've got a plan** for financial success to support your journey at SAIT.

There are lots of ways to pay for your programs, from your own savings and relying on a good budget, to student loans — including Alberta Student Aid, Canada Apprentice Loans and options under the Canada-Alberta Job Grant — scholarships, bursaries and awards. There are also a number of external funding options and community supports available to students.

INTERNATIONAL FEES

The international tuition rate is charged to students, typically temporary residents on a study permit, who are not exempted or unable to provide documentary proof of exempted status to the Office of The Registrar.

Your tuition is calculated based on the number of courses in which you are registered each semester. Additional courses will result in higher total tuition per year.

WHO PAYS INTERNATIONAL TUITION RATES?

You will pay international tuition rates if you are:

- An international student
- Temporary resident with a study permit, work permit or visitor visa
- Living in Canada but do not have permanent resident or refugee status.



International students on a study permit who become Permanent Residents of Canada, Convention Refugees or Protected Persons may be eligible for a fee reassessment and removal of the international differential fee depending on the effective date of their permanent residency or claim.

You must provide the documents before the first day of classes for the differential fee to be removed for an entire term. The differential fee will be applied to the following semester if you provide the documentation after the first day of classes.



INTERNATIONAL FEES.

Estimated costs are based on the SAIT academic year. Visit SAIT.ca to contact us and learn more about tuition for full-time and part-time studies including costs for international students.

WORKING IN CANADA.

International students can work in Canada while studying, provided they are registered as full-time students at SAIT in a designated learning program.

International students with a valid study permit might be eligible to work while studying without a work permit.

Depending on the program you are enrolled in, you might be able to work on-campus only or both on-campus and off-campus. International students cannot work before their studies begin.
