### Position Description

SAIT Athletics and Recreation works to support the success of students by delivering an inclusive and engaging student-life experience. - Assist with the planning, development and delivery of SAIT-wide tournaments.
- Facilitate SAIT gamer introductions and help build a SAIT community of gamers online.
- Provide tips, tricks, and links to support students who are new to gaming.
- Play and engage with players and teams in a variety of games including but not limited to:
  - League of Legends
  - Rocket League
  - Super Smash Bros. Ultimate
  - Chess
  - Fighting games genre
- Attend student leadership training and other relevant professional development and training sessions that will be offered throughout each semester.
- Engage in other duties as opportunities allow.
