POLICY

The policy of the Board of Governors is to ensure that SAIT adheres to the *Election Finances and Contributions Disclosure Act*. SAIT is prohibited from making financial contributions to registered political parties, registered constituency or electoral district associations, or registered candidates as defined by that legislation, and from contributing to any political fund raising function.

DEFINITIONS

Political fund raising function Any function held for the purpose of raising funds for a registered party, a registered constituency or electoral district association, or a registered candidate by whom or on whose behalf the function is held.
