

Pride at SAIT Committee – Roles

The Pride at SAIT Committee is looking for new members to help us support and advocate for the LGBTQ2+ community and their allies at SAIT by fostering and advancing an inclusive campus community for students, faculty and staff. In striving to create a welcoming and safe environment, the committee supports LGBTQ2+ employees and students through community programming, outreach, education, training, and advocacy.

Candidates who identify as LGBTQ2+ or are otherwise marginalized on the grounds of gender expression, gender identity, and/or sexual orientation are strongly encouraged to apply, as are those with lived experience as a member of any marginalized community. If you require an accommodation due to disability to participate in the recruitment and selection process, please advise at any point and we will work with you to meet your needs.

Programming and Activities Team Member

Oversees the development and delivery of all Pride at SAIT student engagement programming with the support of event volunteers. These activities may include the annual Rainbow Reception, Out of the Closet Clothing Sale, and other activities.

Student Leadership Team Member

Oversees the Pride Student Leaders who assist the committee with delivery of LGBTQ2+ supports, engagement activities, and overall connection to the student LGBTQ2+ community.

Communications Team Member

Oversees the development and execution of the annual Pride at SAIT communications strategy/plan. This includes content creation for the sait.ca [Pride at SAIT](#) page and responding to all inquiries at pride@sait.ca.

Education and Training Team Member

Oversees the delivery of workshops, trainings, and certifications relating to LGBTQ2+ topics at SAIT.

Administration Team Member

Oversees meeting support, processing student name-change requests, and maintenance of the Pride at SAIT annual workplan and shared committee files and workspaces.

Assessment Team Member

Ensures that all committee assessments, surveys, and measurements reflect the goals of Student Engagement, SAIT's Strategic Plan, the LAS Strat Plan, and the EDI plan. Works with the committee to create, distribute, and report on Pride at SAIT associated surveys.

Community Relations Team Member

Manages the portfolio of stakeholders that the committee works with outside of SAIT. This may include local services and supports, performers, guest speakers, donors, etc.

Member at Large

Along with the other members of Pride at SAIT Committee, the Member-at-Large participates in the activities of the committee and supports all Pride at SAIT portfolios on an as-needed basis.
